Balashram is a nurturing facility, providing approximately 500 children with free food, quality medical care and outstanding education, with the hopes of ensuring viable futures for its children.

Curriculum Updates

Balashram's administration continues to seek ways of improving the offerings and curriculum at the school. It was decided in the annual School Management Committee ("SMC") meeting to teach Sanskrit as an additional language to students in Grades 3-7. Students are already learning English, Hindi and the local Oriya language. The Committee also decided to apply for Central Board of Secondary Education ("CBSE") affiliation to introduce Arts and Humanities to students in grades 11 and 12 in addition to the Science stream already being offered.

Student Profile

Mandui Soy, a 7th grade student at Balashram was selected by the Indian Rugby Federation to participate in the Societe Generale Kids Rugby Spirit Festival in Japan. She traveled to Japan with the team manager and her Indian teammates on October 22, 2019 for an excitement-filled week-long trip. During the trip, the Indian rugby junior team played a friendly match with the Japan junior rugby team, and Mandui was awarded with a gold medal for her performance in the game. The Deputy Collector of the Kendrapara District, the Director of Physical Education and the District Education Officer all met her and congratulated her on different occasions. Mandui was showered with several sports items from Indian Rugby, Odisha (state) Rugby and Kendrapara District sports organizations. Mandui's journey is inspiring not only to the children of Balashram, but also to the children of nearby villages. Her dream

of being an international rugby player representing India is beginning to blossom, and Balashram is committed to making her dream become a reality.

Healthcare

Millions of people in India have no access to medical care. The medical centers and mobile units we sponsor are able to assist over 100,000 patients a year.

Hariharananda Charitable Health Centers (HCHC)

Prajnana Mission, under the project Hariharananda Charitable Health Centers ("HCHC"), is providing medical services to the poor and needy since 2002. "Over the years, HCHC has made efforts to reach out to an increased number of patients and now treat approximately 120,000 patients each year. HCHC has 5 operational Health Centers with 42 doctors and 14 paramedic staff who are offering specialized services across centers.

- Construction for a new Health Center was completed on February 10, 2020 in Athaharah, Odisha.
- Ayurveda healthcare services were started in the Balighai Health Center on Aug 10, 2019.
- Orthopaedic OPD (Outpatient Department) and Neurology OPD services began in late 2019 and early 2020 at the Jagatpur Health Center.
- A new X-RAY machine, Computed Radiography (CR) system and fully automatic Biochemistry Analyzer has been installed at the Jagatpur Health Center.
